

What is PBIS and the Tiger Paw System?

Positive Behavior Intervention Supports, or PBIS, is a school-wide system of proactive strategies for defining, teaching, and supporting appropriate student behaviors to create positive school environments.

Teaching behavior expectations and rewarding students for following expectations is a much more positive approach than waiting for misbehavior to occur before responding. (www.pbis.org)

Tiger Paws are given for positive behavior and displaying Tiger Pride expectations!

Behavior Reports are given when students do not display appropriate behavior. There are minor reports and major reports. These reports are a communication tool between school and families.

District Goals for Student Improvement:

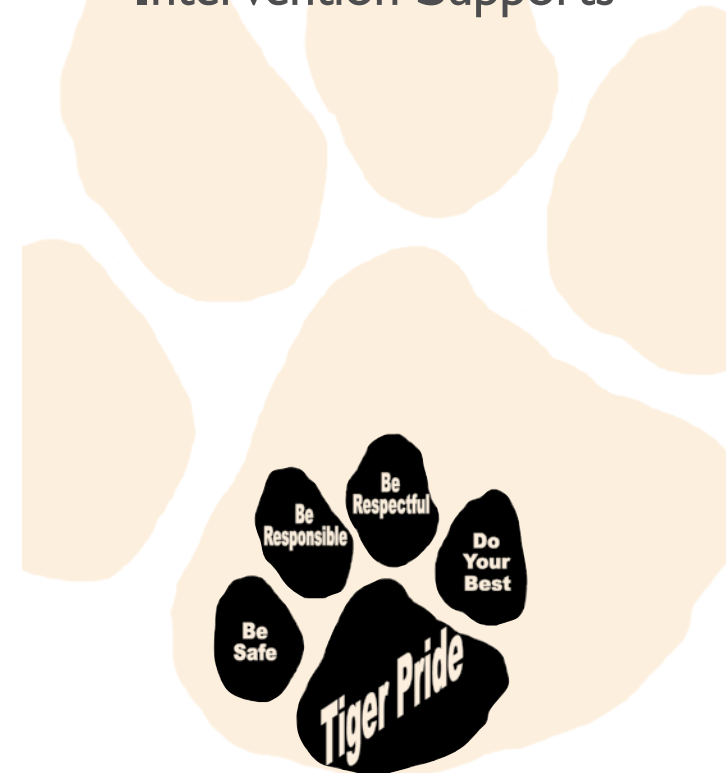
